Syracuse Intergroup Steering Committee Minutes May 9th, 2024

Tom H opened the meeting at 5:38 PM.

Present: Josh C, Sally C, Tanya G, Tim G, Tom H, Brandy C, Tom K

Last Month's Minutes: The committee reviewed April 2024 minutes. Sally made a motion to approve, Tim seconded, and the minutes were approved unanimously.

Tom K presented the unreconciled financial report:

Current Month: Checking and savings accounts are reconciled – total cash as of 4.30.24 is \$71,884 net of \$384 of sales tax leaves \$79,500 of available cash at 4.30.24. Monthly revenues were \$6,798 (up from last month, trending downward for the year) and monthly expenses were \$13,459 (double the normal monthly expenditures, trending moderately upward if adjust for inventory purchased) resulting in a net loss of (\$6,661) Contributions were \$3,305 (trending downward for the year) and literature sales were \$2,713 (trending upward from the Roundup). The was also \$700 of miscellaneous Roundup revenues.

Year to Date: As of April 30th, 2024, with the year 33.33% complete, total revenues are \$32,732 which is 38.93% of the budgeted amount. Total contributions are at 37.78% of the budgeted amount, group contributions are at 37.06% of the budgeted amount and individual contributions are at 114.43% of the budgeted amount. Literature sales are at 41.00% of the budgeted amount – all revenue sources are running above the budgeted amounts. The year-to-date expenses are \$34,869, which is 41.47%, significantly more than budgeted amount. If the inventory purchased is adjusted for the year-to-date expenses are 34.77% of the budgeted amount. The year-to-date net loss is income is (\$2,137) vs the year-to-date net loss of (\$542) as of 4.30.23.

Comparison Year to Date April 2024 vs April 2023: The year-to-date revenues are up 12.48% as compared to last year - \$32,732 vs. \$29,100. The year-to-date expenses are up 17.63% as compared to last year - \$34,869 vs. \$29,642. If the inventory purchased is adjusted for the April 2024 to date expenses are up 6.13% over April 2023.

Service Center: April Office Statistics:

- 129 total calls (down 7% from March)
- 105 total office visits (down 3% from March)
- 167 email responses (up 64% from March)
- Total of 1,403 contacts in the first four months of 2024, compared to 1,677 for the same time period in 2023 (difference of -16%)

Intergroup: Brandy summarized the April Intergroup meeting: Corrections: 2 men and 2 women are bringing meetings into Onondaga Country Justice Center weekly. Treatment: Weekly meetings are still happening at Helio in Liverpool. Intergroup Picnic is May 19th at Pratts Falls. Old Business, Tanya G appointed as new office manager. No New Business. Meeting adjourned at 6:21 PM.

Old Business: Liability insurance was renewed by Sally for NYS Fair on 5/10/24.

New Business: The Steering Committee service rotation schedule was discussed, so that vacancies can be filled in a timely manner when they occur.

New Business: The Steering Committee had a unanimous vote to adjust the Service Center Manager work schedule. Decision was made for Tanya to work Monday-Thursday (4 days a week instead of 3.) Fridays will remain with another service center employee.

Tim made a motion to close, which was seconded by Tom H; meeting adjourned at 6:19 PM.
